Artful Antics (June 4-8)

Calling all artists! Each day we'll explore a different artistic technique: weaving, printmaking, sculpture, mosaics and paint pouring. Activities include weaving with ribbon and nature objects, potato masher printmaking, mosaic candle holders, 3D wire sculptures and abstract painting on canvas. Be sure to visit our outdoor art exhibition at the end of the week to see what the children have created!

All You Need is a Box (June 11-15)

Everyone knows the best part of getting a big present is playing with the big box it came in! Let your imagination soar as you create a train, a tower, a robot or whatever inspires you! Calling all pretenders to join us at camp this week for plenty of dress up time and imaginative play as we use boxes to create whatever we're dreaming about! Ooey Goey Concoctions (June 18-22)

We'll use a 2-liter bottle to make a sprinkler, paint with colored water and ice, have a water balloon hunt and create sculptures with wet sponges and foam balls.
